

BYLAW 5

APPOINTMENT OF THE STUDENT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

5.1 Nomination and appointment of the Directors shall be held in September each year.

5.1.1 Nominations

Nomination papers for each candidate shall be made available at the SAOC office and shall be signed by at least four students within the student's school and filed at least three days before the candidate interview date.

5.1.2 The nomination form shall be signed indicating that the nominee is aware of the requirements of the position and is willing and capable of fulfilling the obligations of office.

5.1.3 Only members of the SAOC may be candidates for a Student Board of Directors position.

5.1.4 All nominees must review the Duties and Responsibilities of Directors.

5.1.5 A valid nomination form must include:

- (a) The name, current address, telephone number, and student ID number of the candidate;
- (b) The school and program in which the student is enrolled;

5.2 Appointment

5.2.1 Appointment of Directors shall take place after closing of the nominations.

5.2.2 If only two nominations have been received from a school, the nominated candidates will be appointed by acclamation.

5.2.3 If more than two nominations have been received, Executive Council shall interview each nominee. The Executive Council shall then make the final decision as to the appointment and inform the nominees.

5.2.4 Each nominee shall have the opportunity to rescind their nomination before the decision of appointment.

5.3 Accountability/Responsibility

5.3.1 All members of SBOD have an obligation to fulfill the duties as outlined in their job description. Failure to fulfill these duties will result in an evaluation of the performance of the individual.

5.3.2 The evaluation will be an agenda item at a regular Executive Council meeting. If further action is required, the evaluation will progress to SBOD for further discussion and possible action. The SBOD reserves the right to remove any member who is unsatisfactorily fulfilling his/her duties as per Bylaw 6.
