**Policy Statement**

The SAOC will establish guidelines regarding alcohol events held in The Crossing.

**Purpose:**

To determine SAOC’s role in sanctioning alcohol based events in The Crossing, particularly for events that specifically include “drinking games.”

A drinking game is any game that involves the drinking of alcoholic beverages.

Procedure

1. All alcohol events must receive sanction from the SAOC.
2. Any event that involves a drinking game held in The Crossing must first be sanctioned by the SAOC as per SAOC policy on club events.
3. All drinking games must include the option to participate using a non-alcoholic beverage.
4. The SAOC reserves the right to refuse to sanction any alcohol based event to be held in The Crossing.
5. All events will abide by college policy on alcohol consumption.
6. The Crossing follows Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission laws, and will act accordingly with any patron who consumes alcohol in The Crossing.
